



CRIMINAL JUSTICE STUDENT SPONSORSHIP



The City of Anderson is seeking applicants to participate in a program to provide qualified individuals with the opportunity to attend a P.O.S.T. Basic Police Officer Training Academy and future employment with the City of Anderson.

Upon satisfactory completion of an extensive background investigation, which includes a polygraph examination, psychological examination, physical examination/drug screening and an administrative review, applicants will be enrolled in and must be available to attend a 23-week P.O.S.T. Basic Police Officer Training Academy designed to provide a comprehensive overview of the criminal justice system and specialized training in various laws, police practices and procedures, law enforcement techniques, first aid and physical conditioning; Must be 21 or older at time of graduation from the Police Academy; Must meet, or exceed the following qualifications – Possess a High School Diploma/G.E.D., a valid California Driver's License and a satisfactory driving record. U.S. Citizenship is mandatory.

Upon graduation from the P.O.S.T. academy, sponsored individuals will have priority consideration for employment with the City of Anderson. This is a sponsorship program to assist the criminal justice student in recruiting and training to become a potential Police Officer. This is not an employment contract.

Applicants interested in becoming a Police Officer who have not yet attended a P.O.S.T. training academy, and meet the requirements noted above, should submit a Sponsorship Application to: City of Anderson, Personnel Department, 1887 Howard Street, Anderson, CA 96007.
