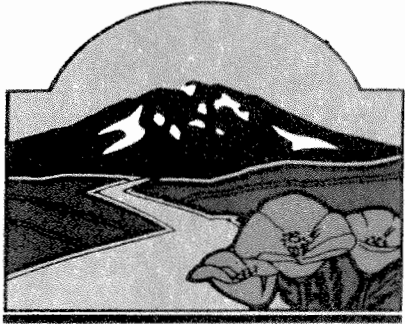

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON EXPRESSING  
APPRECIATION TO PHIL BURNETT  
FOR HIS NEARLY TEN YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CITY OF ANDERSON**

**WHEREAS**, on January 5, 1999, Phil Burnett was appointed by the Anderson City Council to serve as a member of the Anderson Planning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Burnett was elected to the Anderson City Council on November 7, 2000, and, after being sworn in as a City Councilmember on December 5, 2000, concluded his term of service as a Planning Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, during Commissioner Burnett's term on the Anderson Planning Commission, the City experienced successes in several planning matters; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Burnett, after completing a successful first term as a member of the Anderson City Council, was re-elected to a second term on the Anderson City Council on November 2, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, during Councilman Burnett's two terms on the Anderson City Council, the City of Anderson experienced successes in several projects in which Councilman Burnett exercised leadership, including the relocation and renovation of a historic one-room schoolhouse from Shasta College to the Anderson Historical Society house museum property on Ferry Street in Anderson, the construction of a new fishing pier in an Anderson River Park pond that is fully accessible to the physically disabled, an improved business climate in historic downtown Anderson, including the new Copadouro Coffee Shop and Club 49 Jazz Bar businesses, and the development of a new Teen Center building.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Anderson, on behalf of the staff, citizens and businesses of the City of Anderson, that City Councilman Phil Burnett is hereby acknowledged and appreciated for his nearly ten years of service to the City of Anderson.
