## SUBJECT

**Appointment to the Anderson Planning Commission.**

## RECOMMENDATION

Councilman James Yarbrough recommends that the City Council:

**Appoint Susan Baugh to fill the vacancy on the Anderson Planning Commission.**

## FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact of this appointment.

## DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND

Anderson Municipal Code §2.48.020 and §2.48.040 set forth the terms of City Council appointment members of the Anderson Planning Commission. The Code reads, in part:

*“ ... Each councilman upon first entering office shall be entitled to nominate an individual to be a planning commissioner subject to appointment by majority vote of the full council. Should the council fail to appoint a particular nominee, the councilman making the nomination may continue making nominations until the council approves a nominee by appointment to the commission. ... The term of each commissioner shall be concurrent with the term of the councilman who nominated the commissioner for the position.”*

On December 2, 2008, Councilman James Yarbrough recommended, and the City Council approved, the seeking of Planning Commission applicants through January 2, 2009, and setting interviews of Planning Commission candidates for January 20, 2009. The City Clerk noticed the opportunity for candidates to apply, and two candidates applied by the January 2, 2009, deadline. On January 20, 2009, the City Council interviewed two applicants for Planning Commission. The interviewed applicants were:

- Susan Baugh
- Deni Jordan

In accordance with the terms of the Anderson Municipal Code, and with the notice, applications received, and interview conducted by the City Council on January 20, 2009, Councilman James Yarbrough is now entitled to nominate a member of the Planning Commission concurrent with his term of office – that is until December 4, 2012.

After consideration of the candidates interviewed on January 20, 2009, Councilman James Yarbrough nominates Susan Baugh as a member of the Anderson Planning Commission for a term coterminous with his term of office.
