

CITY OF ANDERSON FALL CLEAN UP IDEAS

FALL LEAF PROGRAM

Autumn is here, which means leaves are falling. If you live in a neighborhood with a lot of mature trees, now would be a good time to start planning what to do with all those fallen leaves.

#1 Use your green waste containers for leaves and other yard debris. This will help all in keeping gutters and drains cleared and neighborhoods clean until we can get there!

#2 November through December the city will conduct it's annual leaf pick up as time allows. There is no set schedule. Leaves should be left loose, do not put them in plastic bags. Branches and other wood waste should be self-hauled to Wheelabrator to be recycled. *Residents are asked to make joint piles with their neighbors in the parking area of the street, away from the curbs, fences, and to park their vehicles off the street between 7:00am and 3:00pm, Monday through Friday during these times.*

REMINDERS/HELPFUL HINTS

Please set your waste carts at the curb no later than 6:00am and remove from the street as soon as possible to a location away from the front of the house, to prevent obstructions for other city services as well as keeping your neighborhoods looking neat and clean. Servicing residents in cul-de-sacs is notoriously difficult for garbage trucks as well as street sweepers. Adequate clearance is needed to turn around.




Many new neighborhoods are being developed in Anderson all of which will need street sweeping service. In order to keep up with the demand, we need to focus on sweeping street debris-not leaves. Street sweepers are not designed to sweep large piles of leaves. They are too low to the ground to be effective. Sweepers can only handle the leaves that fall in the street naturally. Please help us this fall by using your green waste carts for leaves.



Basketball hoops interfere with sweepers and solid waste collection vehicles and are hard to see when it is dark. Anderson Municipal Code prohibits obstructions from being placed in the street, alley or sidewalk. Put your hoops and collection carts away after use.
