

ORDINANCE NO. 823

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON
AMENDING THE ANDERSON MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING AN ORDINANCE
REGULATING THE STORAGE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the proposed Ordinance seeks to impose a penalty on any person who stores their personal property on any public property; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement frequently encounters scenarios where individuals dump personal property on City owned property or store personal property on public property without City consent. This personal property can be unsightly and offensive to members of our community attempting to utilize those portions of the City. Further, on occasions, this personal property can result in safety hazards when left to impede a public travel way; and

WHEREAS, a variation of this was previously contained in Chapter 8.26, pertaining to camping in public. As the storage of personal property is, by itself, not camping in public, this separate Ordinance is being proposed for purposes of clarity.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Chapter 8.27 – Storage of Personal Property on Public Property

8.27.010 – Prohibition

It shall be unlawful for any person to store personal property, including camp facilities and camp paraphernalia, on any City owned property.

8.27.020- Penalties

Any person violating this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause it to be posted and/or published in accordance with the law.


